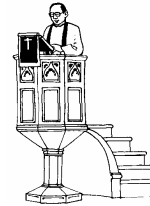
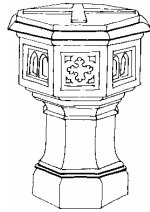
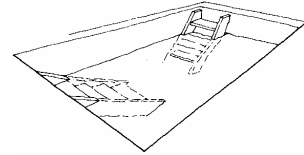
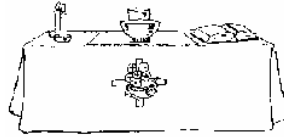


# Talk About Church Buildings



Try to visit a church and a chapel, or look at their virtual tours on the RE:Quest website.



1. Talk about the things you found in each building. Think about what they were used for (altar / communion table; pulpit / platform / lectern; font / baptistery; musical instruments; stoup / confessional / sanctuary lamp; Bible / song books). You might like to draw pictures and explain what you found.
2. Is there a Priest or a Minister? Do people wear special clothes? What happens in the church services? What happens for children, and to help other people in the community? What special things happen at festivals like Christmas, Easter and Harvest?
3. Talk about how each church building made you feel. Was it still and peaceful? Was it comfortable and 'homely'? Why?
4. How do the Christians who meet in each building show their respect and love for God? To Christians, these are special places. What other special places are there? What makes them special? How should we treat such places? Why? Do you have a special place?
