

# The Good Samaritan: Jesus Teaches About Caring for Outcasts



A parable is an imaginary story told to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson.

Task: To find out what Christians believe their attitude should be towards outcasts in society, by looking at the parable of The Good Samaritan.

1. Read the story from the Bible. You can find it in Luke chapter 10 verses 25 – 37. One person can read it aloud to the group.
2. Go to 'Bible – Life and Teaching of Jesus' and choose 'The Good Samaritan'

3. Read the story carefully, and then go to the quiz. There are ten questions to test your knowledge of the story!
4. Make a poster to show what Christians believe their attitude should be towards outcasts in society, after looking at the parable of The Good Samaritan.
