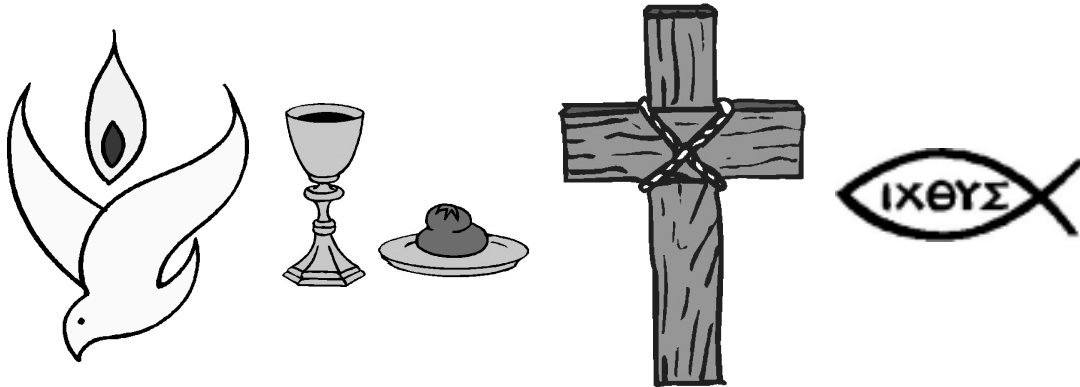


Expressions of Belief: Christian Symbols



We have looked at Christian symbols – now try this:

1. With an adult, think about symbols that Christians use, and other symbols that you see – badges and logos that you know. Think about what information they give other people.
2. Talk about what information you could give about yourself. Make a list of the sorts of things which are important to people, including their achievements, things that have caused them pain or joy, and things they aim for.
3. Design a badge or logo that says something meaningful about yourself – not just “I can swim well” for instance, but about what you think is most important to you in your life. For instance, instead of perhaps just saying “My Mum” you should try to show in what ways your family is important to you.
4. Next to your badge or logo write an explanation of its meaning. This is the assessment of your understanding of the task.
