1. What does the word "worship" mean?
2. Why does it matter to Christians that the Bible uses the same word for "worship" and "service"?
3. Describe the different kinds of worship described in the Bible.
4. What is liturgy?
5. How is the Bible used in worship?
6. Describe the ways that songs and music vary between churches? Which do you think you might prefer?

WORSHIP - PERSONAL SEARCH

1. Look again at the pictures of people worshipping. Think about how people might feel in different kinds of worship situations? How do you think these different emotions can make people feel closer to God?
2. Why do you think some Christians prefer to use liturgy? Why do you think other Christians prefer more informal worship? Why do you think some like worship led by a priest or minister and others prefer it to be led by church members?
3. Have you ever sat quietly in a cathedral, or other place of worship, or a place that is special to you? Describe how you felt while you were there. 4. Look in the Churches section of the RE:Quest website. Compare the worship that may be found in churches of different Christian denominations (groups). e.g. compare Roman Catholic and Pentecostal, or Church of Scotland and Quaker, or Anglican and Baptist.
